Flood relief update

We have several quilts that have been made by guild members and will be donated to victims of the recent flooding that happened in Nebraska. The organizer of this effort said that they have over 300 quilts so far and that their goal is 500. They plan to have a car caravan delivering quilts, starting in Stuart and then heading down to Lynch where people lost everything. Anyone else who would like to donate a quilt of any size (new or used-in good condition) to the Nebraska Flood relief effort will need to bring your donation to the August guild meeting. They have asked that a piece of paper be pinned to the quilt with the size so they can organize them. Cards or notes to the recipient attached to the quilt would be a lovely touch.

Threads Across Nebraska

The guild has been invited to submit quilts for the Nebraska State Quilt Guild's annual quilt show in October. Since the event is in Kearney, the guild will line up a volunteer to take the quilts to Kearney and a

Workshop: Thread Painted Portraits

Instructor: Lea McComas

Use free-motion stitching on a printed fabric foundation to thread paint a portrait. Begin with a basic blending and contour exercises before moving on to the stitching individual facial features. Learn how to select appropriate threads and how stitching lines can be blended and contoured to create a realistic facial image. Additionally, learn tricks for adding detail and ways of manipulating the background to support the overall composition. The workshop also includes instruction on photo editing as well as larger, more complex, or multiple projects.



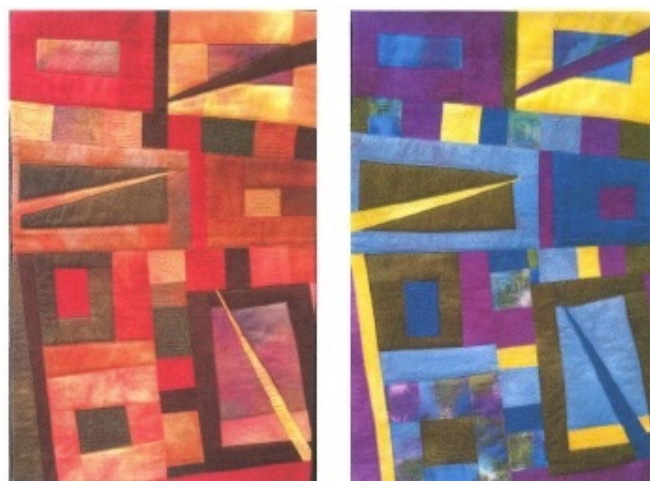

Workshop: Cracked Boxes

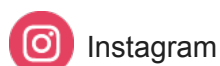
Instructor: Ilene Bartos
