President-Elect Announcements - Nancy Anderson

- The Board would like to thank everyone who donated fabric for the Isles Garage Sale. Our inventory of fabric was less than last year but more than previous years. We made approximately \$560. We are planning to participate in the garage sale again next year. So, as you start your spring cleaning or finish a project, be sure to set aside fabric to donate next year.
- National Quilting Day was a big success thanks to volunteers from LQG! We had over six hundred people attend and
 enjoyed all the offerings. The IQM staff was very pleased as well. Mark your calendars for March 18, National Quilting
 Day 2023! Special thanks to Sheila Green, Chair; Kathy Spitsen and Rosalind Carr, Committee Members for making it
 happen.
- Reminder the June guild meeting will be the 2nd Monday and will be held at the IQM. This is a change from the past when we typically met on the 3rd Monday in June. We will see you here at the church for next month's meeting on May 9, but then we will see you at IQM on June 13th.
- Volunteers are needed for the Silent Auction planned for October this year (contact Connie Soucie) and for the committee to help with the 50th anniversary in 2023 (contact Lisa Burham)
- The Nebraska State Quilt Guild has several things coming up:
 - 2022 Raffle Quilt is on display tonight "Feathered Fantasy". Tickets are \$1 / each and the winner will be selected July 23rd.
 - Quilter's Day Out, April 23, 2022 @ Heartland Museum of Military Vehicles in Lexington, NE. More information about this event is on the information table.
 - They will be hosting Quilt Nebraska 2022 from July 21 24 in Kearney, NE. National and regional teachers will be present. Registration will be available on the NSQG website on April 15th.
 - o October 7th & 8th will be the 17th Annual Threads Across Nebraska.
 - This event is being held at the Buffalo County Fairgrounds in Kearney at the Exposition building.

- Sheila Green is the featured guilter.
- The Threads Across Nebraska committee has invited our Guild to be a part of this event and has asked us to provide:
 - Ten large guilts large wall hanging to bed guilts 64 x 64 or larger
 - Ten small quilts miniatures to large wall hangings smaller than 64 x 64
 - Only one guilt per guilter be chosen.
 - In addition, there will be a special section of Temperature Quilts. If you have made a temperature quilt, submit it in addition to the other quilts.
 - Deadline for the Guild to select these quilts is the August 8th meeting so that we can meet the September 1 deadline for registration.
 - If interested in submitting a guilt, please contact Nancy Anderson.
- The Guild has received inquiries about making quilts for others. The information about the quilts and contact information is on the information table. This includes a request for a quilt for a wedding in June, a t-shirt quilt with Harley Davidson t-shirts, and a quilt from a child's dance costumes. Information on other events in the area are also on the table.

• IQM Liaison – Sandy Hanson

- There are currently eighty-one red and white quilts that are part of the Joanna S Rose Red and White Collection.
 These are hanging in the West Gallery.
- These quilts are stunning. They are hung very creatively up to four quilts high. It is the first collection to be featured during the celebration of the 25th year of the International Quilt Museum. This exhibit will hang until September 10, 2022.
- The IQM has over 6,000 quilts from over fifty countries and covering five different centuries. We are so fortunate
 to have this in Lincoln where we can access it and enjoy it often.
