IQM Liaison Report to LQG – Sandy Hansen

Exhibits currently at the International Quilt Museum:

West Gallery - to 04-15-23, "Water Featured the John M. Walsh III Collection." Mr. Walsh commissioned various quilt artists to create works featuring their idea of water. Huge variety of methods – including thread painting, stencil, printed, collage layers, velveteen with lovely quilting.

Peg Coryell, Lois Ann Gottsch, and Doris Von Seggern Galleries – to 03-25-23. "Uncovering Black History – Quilts from the Collection of Carolyn Mazloomie" This exhibit will be shown in all three single galleries. The tags have great explanations, but overhearing a docent gave even more interesting and pertinent information on each piece.

Pumphrey Family Gallery : Paula Nadelstern- "I Am a Patternista" – to 04-08-23. These wall hangings are complex designs full of patterns developed through the fabric – giving the effect of elaborate designs.

Hours at the International Quilt Museum are Tuesday through Saturday, 10 – 4 each day (closed on Sunday and Monday to visitors). . Admission for non-members is \$8 per person.

President Recap – Connie Soucie

Connie thanked the board and Guild members for making 2022 a tremendous year. We had great programs again this year, with wonderful attendance from our members. Current membership is approximately 190.

- New members joining in the year = 8
- Average attendance this year = 103 per month
- Total guests during the year = 41 (26 in October alone)

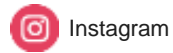
