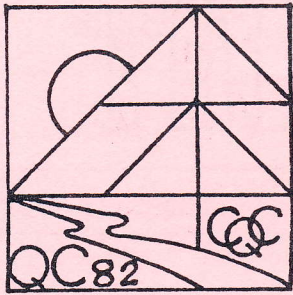

BOOK REVIEW - Courtesy of Maryvonne Burris - OMAHA QUILTERS' GUILD

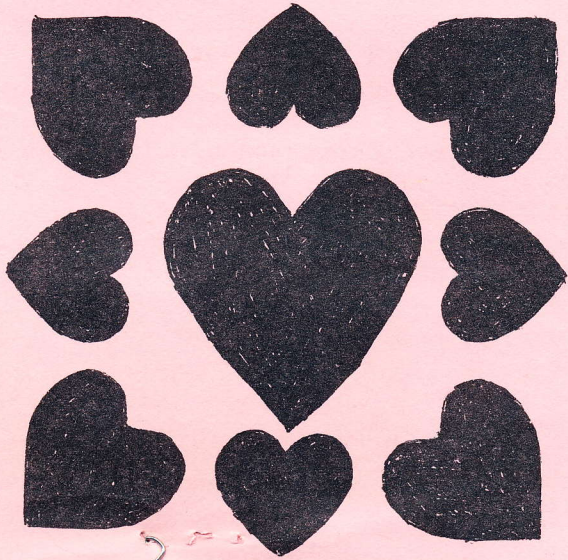

That old, time-consuming job of calculating yardage for all the pieces in your quilt, even down to the binding, borders and backing, is eliminated, at last. Under one cover you can find just about everything you'll need to know. So, no more hours figuring, no more buying extra yardage "just in case" - in fact, no guesswork at all. And best of all, the price is right. \$4.95 plus \$1.00 postage from Quilts and Other Comforts, Box 394, Wheatridge, CO 80033." The Calico House usually carries it, but out. 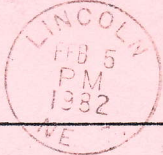
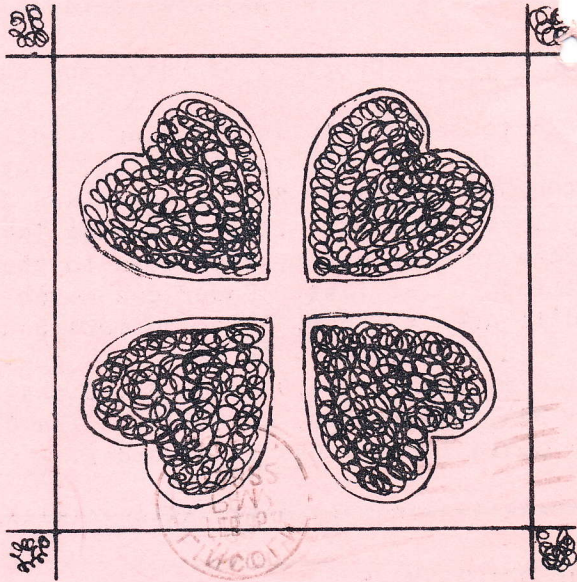
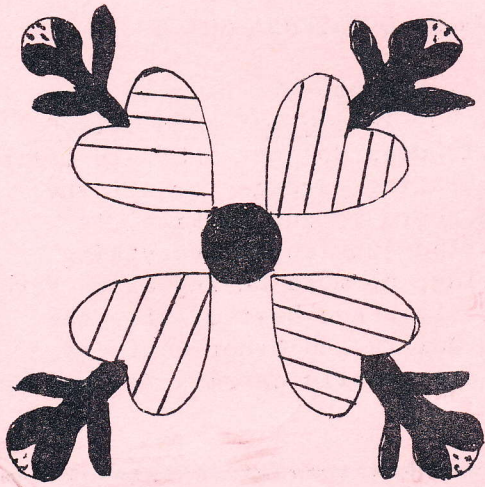
