

# Friendship Block for May

## Japanese Springtime Block

For this pretty springtime block you will need 4 solids and 4 prints — all in pastel colors!

Cut template #1 out of solids — cut 4 of each solid  
 Cut template #2 out of prints — cut 4 of each print

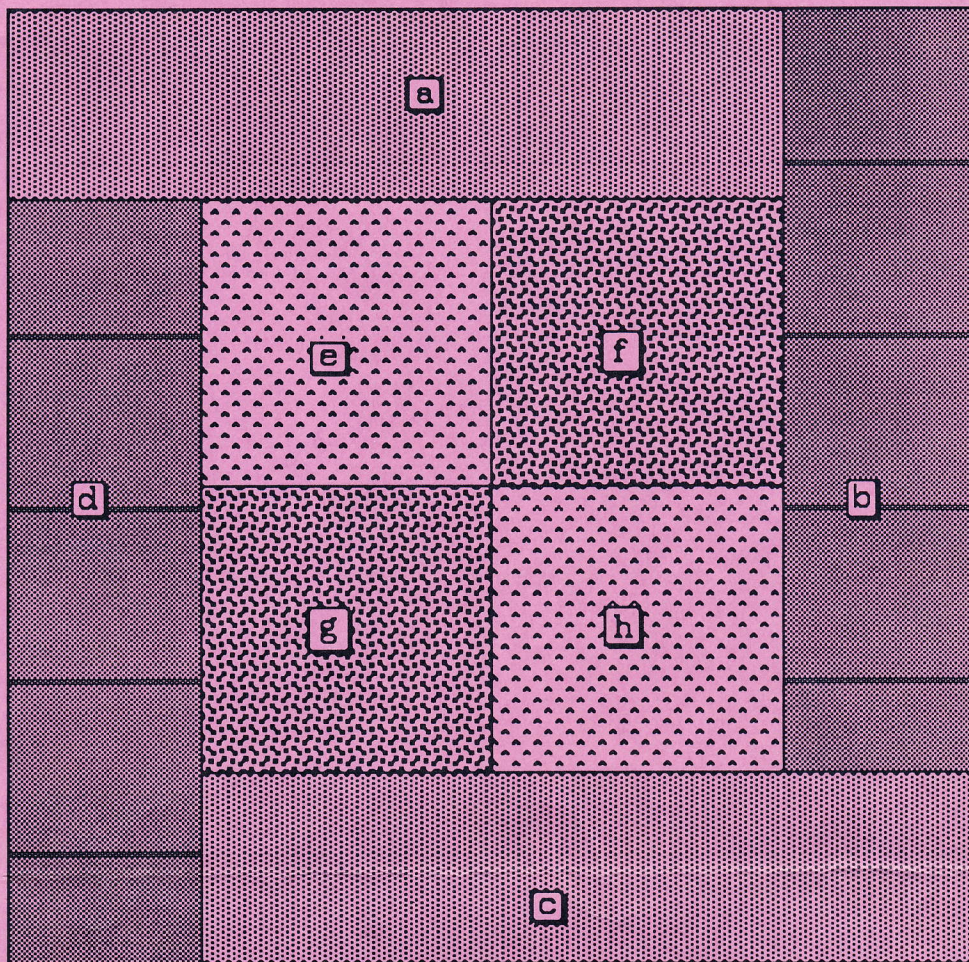
Follow the diagram closely for placement of colors.

Strip "a" and strip "c" are the same color; strip "b" and strip "d" are the same color.

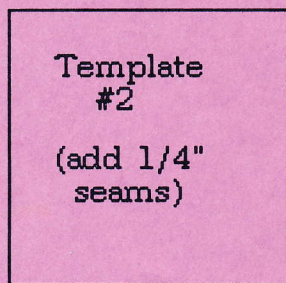
Square "e" and square "h" are the same print; square "f" and square "g" are the same print.

Piece two of the blocks so that they are identical in colors. Then piece two more identical blocks with the remaining fabrics. Determine which pair of blocks are darker in value, then set the large block together placing the lighter and darker blocks as shown in the diagram — lighter in positions A & D, and the darker blocks in positions B & C.
