2. List shows and exhibitions in which you have participated. Give date(s) and location(s); name and describe item(s) entered.
3. List honor(s) received with dates and any relevant information regarding the honor(s).

4. List any teaching positions or assistantships you have received in the past. Include location(s) and date(s).
5. Itemize any of your work which has appeared in journals or newspapers. Include location(s) and date(s).
6. Discuss other relevant experience or background information not covered above.
7. Describe your project. Include a statement of the aims and goals of your research. Include the anticipated time required to complete your project.
8. Describe how the LQG scholarship award money will be spent.
9. Sign and date your application before you send it!

**Reminder 1:** This application must be accompanied by written letters of recommendation from three persons acquainted with your scholarship and/or professional work. We recommend you request the letters be sent to you so that you can include them in your application packet which must be delivered to the committee by March 1.

**Reminder 2:** If awarded an LQG scholarship, you are required to make a presentation about your project to the Lincoln Quilters Guild within a year of the award.
