Attendees had plenty of room and enjoyed seeing everyone's projects and company while we also made progress on our projects! We had very good feedback from those who attended, so we are in process of scheduling another time in the next few months! We will communicate this date as soon as we have confirmation from Barb Sorensen at Sew Creative.

LQG Banquet. I am excited to announce that we are planning a banquet for our **July 13, 2026**, LQG meeting which will be held at the **College View Seventh Day Adventist Church**. A nominal ticket fee of \$5.00 will help us with the cost of the catered meal and will reserve your space. Tickets will be available at the April guild meeting.

250th Anniversary of our Country. Good news! Today, 3/3/2026, I received word that we have been approved by the Nebraska Historical Commission and the Governor to have our 250th Quilt on display in the Governors reception room. There will be an unveiling of the quilt by the Governor with a brief overview of the quilt and its meaning. Final details to come very soon!

The Quilting Experience. I am inviting you to join me in a quilting adventure this year based on the book with the same title by Victoria Findlay Wolfe. It is a 12 block quilt with multiple variations that asks us to reflect on the 12 blocks/chapters: identify, traditions, comfort and healing, connection, aging, teaching and lessons learned, friendship, travel, remembering and grief, food, celebration, and new adventures. The 16th annual National Quilting Day event at the International Quilt Museum in Lincoln is scheduled for Saturday, March 21, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. This FREE community event includes free museum admission and demonstrations, special lectures and displays, as well as access to the current exhibitions.

We will be celebrating the America 250 with large quilt displays and a lecture about Quilts of Valor. The Nebraska State Quilt Guild will share information on how your local community can get involved in sharing your love of America and the art and craft of quilting! Take part in Make & Take projects for all ages, Learn to Quilt, Japanese Boro and Handwork Demonstrations & Displays, Collection Care in Action: Conservation Workroom and fabulous Quilt Exhibitions in the IQM galleries. Our current exhibitions include *Japanese Boro*, *20th Century American Quilts*, *Fashion & Quilts*, *Saitama*, *Machine Quilting: Karen McTavish*.

November Minutes

LINCOLN QUILTERS GUILD MEETING

Monday, November 10, 2025

SDA Church, Lincoln, NE

President Vicky Skuodas called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance. There were 2 guests and 3 new members. The minutes were published in the Plain Print. Kathy Spitsen moved to approve the minutes. Kath Conroy seconded. The minutes were approved. The treasurer's report was also published in the Plain Print. Kathi Schmitter moved to approve the treasurer's report. Sheila Green seconded. The treasurer's report was approved and remanded for audit.

President-elect Liane Connelly reported that Sleep In Heavenly Peace received \$432.27 from the Guild when the basket was passed at the previous meeting. The basket was passed again. Proceeds from the silent auction for two donated quilts will go to Sleep In Heavenly Peace. Sizes for the quilts to be donated for the organization are in the Plain Print and on the website.

Liane announced a quilt retreat on February 20th and 21st at Sew Creative. The cost for one day is \$20. The cost for both days is \$30. The hours are 9 am to 9 pm. The space will hold 25-30 people. Register at Sew Creative by February 2nd. If there are spaces left, it will be opened to the other quilters. Friends are welcome to drop in to visit. Bring a lunch. There is a small kitchenette with a microwave.

Liane reminded members to wear their nametags and suggested that members may wish to make a new nametag during the winter. It helps for all of us to get to know each other! Liane also announced that Vicky Bedell is selling a Bernina for \$40. Her phone number is in the membership directory available on-line.

Liane also read a heart-felt thank you from Rhonda Obermeier from Sleep In Heavenly Peace.

Vicky was presented with a small quilt by Liane as a thank you for all her work as president of the Guild and cash from the board.

Past-president Tammy Hensley announced that the goal for donated star blocks was met tonight. Stars can still be donated. Extra stars will be used to make pot holders for the IQM and Quilts of Valor tops. The blocks can be dropped off at the Sewing Center of Lincoln. The proceeds from the raffle quilt will go to the Military Order of the Purple Heart Auxiliary, which provides food and housing assistance to veterans. The quilt top will be assembled on Wednesday, November 19th at the Sewing Center of Lincoln.

Marty Link reported on the Guild survey. Eighty-seven people responded. The results of the survey are in the Plain Print. She pointed out that responses to Zoom workshops might be OK if they were on Saturday. Fifty-six percent said that Zoom on Mondays for LQG meetings might be OK, but not all the time. The survey showed that the best thing members thought about LQG was the Monday night meetings. Seeing friends and going to small groups were next. Show and Tell was #4. Number 5 was the workshops. Marty said the survey provided a lot of information about workshops. Some people are still working, or responded that it's too hard to take machines, or they already know the technique being taught. There was a lot of interest in having a retreat or a sewing day, and a bus trip. Marty said that Des Moines, Kansas City, and Missouri Star are all about 3 hours away. More than 60% of the members have been quilting more than 20 years. Marty encouraged people to invite younger people to join LQG and sited new members Issac and Adriana.

Deb Hartford of the Newbie Group, reported that the meeting next Monday night will be held at St. Mark's church at 85th and Pioneers from 6-8. There will be show and tell. There will also be a gift exchange of items that are quilt related and that cost approximately \$15. Gifts should be wrapped. Attendees should also bring a treat to share. Kathy Schmitter showed a quilt made by the Newbie's group to donate to Sleep In Heavenly Peace.

Nancy Anderson installed the new Guild officers. Vicky Skuodas is the advisor as past-president. Liane Connolly is the president of the Guild. Marty Link is the president-elect. Lin Gowin Hejl and Michelle Dagerman are vice-presidents for programs. Connie Jones and Ruth O'Gara are VP-elect for programs. Barb Jauken is the treasurer. The Guild still needs a treasurer-elect. Deb Hartford is the secretary. Board members going off the board are Tammy Hensley, Nancy Gerdes, and Pam Wakeman and were thanked.

Sheila Green reported on the upcoming Art Market this Friday and Saturday. Flyers were available at the Discover Nebraska table. Sheila also asked members to sign up to work at National Quilters Day in March. Sign-up sheets are on the table. She thanked Joni Sauter for agreeing to be the representative for LQG on the committee.

The two guests were invited to select a gift. The raffle quilt winner was Jackie Reise. The silent auction winners were Lynn DeShon and Becky Olson.

Natalie Cummings announced mini-raffle winners. Fifty three dollars was collected. A sign-up sheet was passed around for people to donate for next year. Pam Wakeman won a ruler donated by Anonymous, a quilt donated by Bonnie Kucera, and fabric donated by Julie Albrecht. Marti Franti won a quilt donated by Vicky Skuodas and a pattern donated by Anonymous. Joyce Jesse won a ruler and book donated by Kathy Phillips and a quilt by Vicky Skuodas.

Pam Wakeman won a book and fabric donated by Pat Kant Modrell. June Pederson won a quilt made by Laura Lenzen and a ruler donated by Anonymous.

Lin Gowin Hejl and Michelle Dagerman reported on programs for next year. A book mark with a list of programs and workshops were on each chair. The program in March is by Aaron Wentz. He's a Laura Heine instructor and the workshop is Teeny Tiny Truck Collage. November's speaker in 2026 is Natalie Earnheart from Missouri Star Quilting Co.

Speaker Kris Vierra had requested Show and Tell before her program. Her program was entitled The Evolution of an Accidental Quilt Designer. She gave an information packed presentation. Her high energy and breadth of knowledge was impressive, inspirational and enjoyed by all!
